



## Annie Lee Jackson

June 24, 1935 - December 30, 2024

Annie Lee “Granny” Jackson, a vibrant 89-year-old resident of Wetumpka, Alabama, peacefully departed this life on Monday, December 30, 2024, in the comfort of her own home.
