Barbara Lykes 68, a resident of Elmore County transitioned February 1, 2023. Funeral services will be held on Saturday, February 11, 2022, at Eunice M. Mrs. Barbara Jean Lykes-Woodson was born January 22, 1955, in Elmore County to the late Mr. Welton Albert James and Miss Jannie May Walker.
