Mr. Henry Douglas “Enoch” Gill was born on April 24, 1942 to the late Freeman Gill Sr. and Elzena Bowen Gill in Elmore County, Alabama. He committed his life to Christ at an early age and joined First Missionary Baptist Church in Elmore, Alabama.

He graduated from Sandtown High School in Millbrook, Alabama. After graduation, he enlisted in the Army and completed two years. He also served in the Vietnam War during his tenure in the military, and received an honorable discharge.

He was united in holy matrimony to Mary Anna Townsend Gill on November 12, 1966 and from their union, two beautiful children were born.

He worked at Brockway Glass Company from 1966-1987. Later, he became a farmer. He and his brother Willie started the Gill Brothers’ farming business. He worked as a farmer for more than 30 years.
