Ida Mae (Mack) Campbell a resident of Austin Texas, formerly of Elmore County, Alabama transitioned February 23, 2023. Funeral Services will be March 4, 2023, at 11:00A.M. at Eunice M. Mitchell Chapel (Hillside).

Ida was born in Autauga County, Alabama, August 29, 1927, to the late Boise Sr. & the late Ida (Washington) Bowman as the fifth child of eleven.
