Ronald Earl Elliott 75, a resident of Orlando Florida, transitioned May 16, 2023, Funeral Service will be June 16, 2023, at the Alabama National Cemetery in Montevallo, Al, with full military honors.

Ronald Earl Elliott, Master Sergeant USAF (Ret.) of Orlando, Florida passed away on Tuesday, May 16, 2023. Ronald, who was affectionately called "Slim" because of his 6' 6" stature, was born January 5, 1948, in Columbus, Ohio. He was 75.
