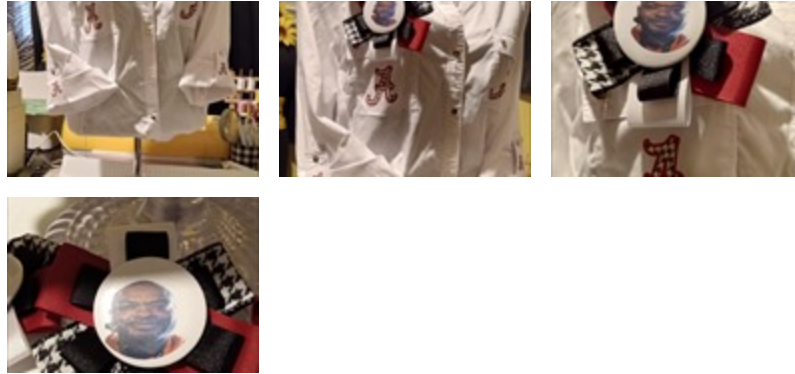

When I see you again*

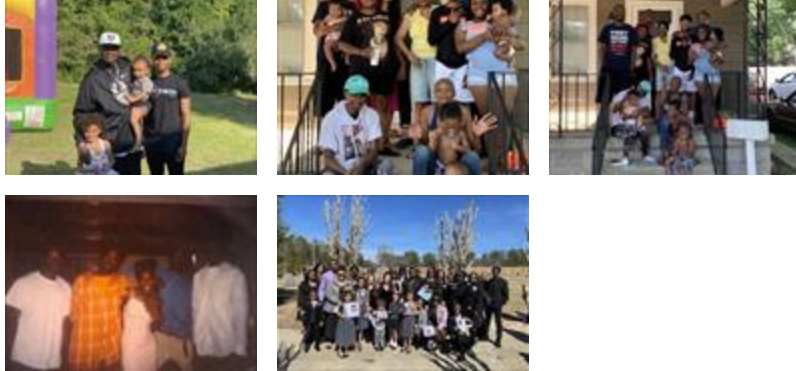
